Half or Partial Knee Replacement

Total Knee Replacement

Wear and tear of knee joints due to arthritis and Increasing age is a very common problem. It is more common in women. In the beginning medicines and exercise help reduce the pain but after a few years the patient must find a permanent solution for the daily pain.

The permanent solution is Total Knee Replacement [TKR] Surgery. After TKR the constant severe pain in the knee is gone for ever in most patients.

TKR is a very popular surgery for the permanent relief of painful knees. Since 2000 AD, hundreds of thousands of patients have undergone TKR.

TKR is a major surgery. All the components of the painful and worn out knee joint are replaced with artificial joint components. The lower part of the thigh bone [femur], the upper part of the leg bone [tibia] and the inner portion of the knee cap [patella] and cut out and replaced with metal alloy, polymer or ceramic components.

Half Knee Arthritis

The thigh bone [femur] has two protuberances called 'condyles' which come in contact with two depressions of the leg bone [tibia]. Thus the knee joint has two small articulating areas.

In some patients only one of these two areas is affected with arthritis or wear and tear. Such patients do not need 'total' knee replacement. They are best treated with partial knee replacement, also called 'Unicondylar' Knee Replacement.

When a person stands up erect, the parts of the knee touching each other are called the medial condyles. While the outer parts of the knee are called the lateral condyles. In most cases when a single condyle is affected, it is the medial or the inner condyle. Such pa-

Disadvantages of TKR

Of all patients who undergo TKR surgeries, about 20% patients are not happy. They still suffer some pain after surgery.

While after unicondylar knee replacement, more than 99% patients enjoy total relief from

tients benefit most with Unicondylar surgery.

Advantages

Unicondylar or half knee replacement has many benefits: • Less blood loss as it is a smallpain. So if you are about to undergo TKR, check whether both of your knee condyles are worn out. If only one condyle is worn out, ask for Unicondylar Knee Replacement.

T Scan for a Pulmonary Angiogram



Most people think about the CT Scanner as an equipment used to diagnose stroke, fractures, contrast studies, comparison of pre operative and post operative images and so on. However, few people know that the CT Scanner is also used for Pulmonary Angiography.

One of the complications of large bone fractures is Pulmonary Embolism, meaning a blood clot from the fractured bone blocks a pulmonary artery. This is a life threatening situation in a patient with broken bones and must be diagnosed and treated as soon as possible. CT Pulmonary Angiography can diagnose pulmonary embolism in minutes.

The patient receives an intravenous injection of an iodine-containing contrast agent fast through an injector pump. Images are acquired with the maximum intensity of radio-opaque contrast in the pulmonary arteries.

A normal CTPA scan will show the contrast filling the pulmonary vessels, appearing as bright white. Any mass filling defects due to emboli, will appear as a dark patch in place of the contrast. And rapid diagnosis helps in immediate treatment for pulmonary embolism, which if not treated in time, can be life threatening.

The Magic of Teeth Restoration

A 61 year old lady came all the way from Africa with a full set of decayed teeth. She had pyorrhoea, a dental disease where pus literally comes of the patient's gums. Poor oral hygiene had led to this stage. She could not eat anything comfortably. Bad breath was another major problem. She could not smile or laugh freely as she had no teeth to show.

She came to Dr Monali Shah of Pushya Hospital in this poor state of Dental Hygiene.

After examining and getting her dental X-Rays done, Dr Monali found that only four upper teeth and five lower teeth could be salvaged. All the remaining teeth were in so poor a condition that they had to be removed.

Ideally dental implants could have been inserted in place of her missing teeth, but the weak condition of her jaw bones because of osteoporosis would not permit that.

So Dr Monali decided to put a 'bridge', that is artificial teeth between the remaining teeth both on the upper and the lower jaws. The natural teeth would have to take the weight of the bridge, and so they had to be sound.

The bridge would fail, if the teeth which took the weight of the bridge became infected.

To prevent that, Dr Monali did Root Canal Treatment [RCT] on the nine remaining teeth first.

She was going to use those teeth to support the 'bridge'.

If these teeth should become painful later, the bridge would have to be removed for their Root Canal Treatment [RCT] and the bridge would have to be removed for that.

To make a bridge the four upper and five lower teeth had to have a certain height. Her old teeth were not tall enough to take the bridge.

So Dr Monali did what is known as the 'post and core' procedure. She put in small implants inside some of the natural teeth to increase their height. On those teeth, she created a bridge, which restored the lady's full denture. Now her teeth look like a healthy set of teeth. Most important, it restored her smile and confidence.

Prostate/Hernia Surgery Surgery at Special Rates

Two diseases which can be treated only with surgery are Hernia and Prostate Enlargement.

Hernia is a small swelling and appears only on certain areas of the body. In the beginning it disappears when pressed. But with passage of time the swelling keeps on increasing and eventually it cannot be made to disappear by pressing. At



that stage surgery becomes necessary.

Enlargement of the Prostate usually occurs in men above 60. Patients suffer from frequent micturition, inability to completely empty the urinary bladder, and great difficulty in voiding urine if the patient holds urine for a long time. It is best treated by Prostectectomy by Laser Surgery. There is minimal blood loss, and the catheter is removed in only 24 hours. Such surgeries are routinely done in Pushya Hospital.
