The reasons I chose Spine Surgery were: It requires high surgical skill and highly sophisticated surgical equipment. Spine surgeries succeed only with state of the art instruments and highly skilled surgical team. Besides, spine surgery demands cessful treatment is our greatest minimally invasive techniques. I motivation. That is why our misliked the challenge.

Spine Surgery requires highly

specialized equipment like 3-D-C-Arm, Navigation, Operating Microscope, Endoscope and so on. Over and above that post operative care is crucial. After spine surgery the patients are very vulnerable. Taking extreme care of such patients and helping them move and walk as early as possible requires a highly skilled team of health care professionals like nurses, patient care assistants, physiotherapists and other paramedical staff.

Most corporate hospitals of international repute try their best to provide ideal post surgical care, but patients do not get the care we demand. Our patients were not getting the level of personalized care we expected. So I had decided many years ago to establish our own hospital some day and give ideal patient care. We have fulfilled our dream through the new Pushya Hospital.

To maintain sophisticated operation theatres with high end equipment only for spine surgery is not cost effective. So we included other specialities like Orthopaedics, Joint Replacement, Trauma, Urology and Dentistry In Pushya Hospital.

Admitted on a Stretcher; Discharged Walking!

For a healthy person, the act of walking erect is simple and taken for granted. But for a patient with an injured & displaced vertebra pressing on the spinal cord and nerves, the excruciating pain and lack of sensation and partial paralysis, even standing is not possible, walking is impossible.

The good news is, such patients can be surgically treated. And with proper post operative care they can walk!

However, such surgeries are very risky. Only a highly skilled Spine Surgery Team with the best surgical instruments and equipment can make such surgeries successful.

A former Member of the Legislative Assembly of Gujarat Mr Kamabhai Rathod suffered an injury on his neck in 2014. He was in extreme pain. He could not even stand up. His body below the neck had lost sensation, he could barely move his limbs. He was brought to Spine Surgeon Dr Viral Shah in such a poor state.


C. T. Scan and M.R.I. studies showed that Kamabhai's seventh cervical vertebra had moved from it's place. It was pressing on the spinal cord and the adjoining nerves. As a result he had suffered 'Quadriparesis', a condition where he had partially lost sensation and movement in both his arms and legs and most of his body. He also suffered severe pain around his neck. At that time

his life was in danger. If the displaced vertebra moved further, he might have been permanently paralysed.

At that stage, spine surgeon Dr Viral Shah operated on Kamabhai and restored the displaced vertebra in its proper position. Dr Viral then fixed




the vertebra so that it would not move from its position.

Four years have passed since that high risk surgery. Now Kamabhai can easily walk erect.

If you meet him, you would feel as if Kamabhai never had suffered any injury at all!

The Challenges

Spine surgery is often compared to a goldsmith's work, very fine and intricate. Even a small error may result in non relief of pain or worse, loss of function. Besides,

- Spine surgeons have to operate in very small areas.
- Nerves and soft tissue, which can be easily cut, lie very close to vertebrae, which are as hard as wood.
- It is very easy to damage nerves while cutting bones or cartilages. Till a decade ago, Spine Surgery was not considered to be a safe

form of surgery as many surgeries resulted in unsatisfactory outcomes.

The Cutting Edge

However, in current times especially with the help of state of the art techniques like 3-D C Arm and Spine Navigation, the treatment of Spine injuries and Diseases has become very accurate and safe in Pushya Hospital.

3-D C Arm + Navigation


C Arm is a basic equipment used in most operation theatres since many years. It shows the operating surgeon the exact location of the organ to be operated and the exact location of the instruments of the surgeons. The older types of C Arms are cumbersome instruments which a technician has to manipulate so that the operating surgeons can ensure that the screws and plates are fixed in the exact location. Repeated use of C Arms exposes the surgons and the staff to radiation.

The 3-D C Arm + Navigation in Pushya Hospital on the other hand are computer controlled. The 3-D C Arm moves on its own to take scans and displays cut sections of the spine in three dimensions, front to back, side to side and a cut section as shown above.

That helps the spine surgeons to place the screws and plates exactly at the right location. A few mm deviation in screw placement may *not* move an erant vertebra away from a nerve, and the patient will continue to have pain due to pressure on nerves.

Exact Location

To view the surgeon's equipment on Navigation display, Infra Red markers are placed on instruments, screws and vertebrae. It is the skill of placing and fitting artificial prostheses in the exact location that gives the best outcomes.







Award for a Decade of Skilled Work

Fifteen years is just a beginning for a super specialist spine surgeon, says founder of Pushya Hospital and recipient of the HEROES OF 2018 award Dr Viral Shah. The award, bestowed on great achievers of different fields by the Hon. Mayor of Ahmedabad Ms Bijal Patel at a grand ceremony.

After completing his Masters in Orthopaedic Surgery in 2001, Dr Viral decided to specialise in Spine Surgery, one of the most difficult branches of Orthopaedics. Dr Viral's skills in Orthopaedics were honed by legendary teacher in Orthopaedics Professor Dr Dinubhai Patel, who encouraged Dr Viral's decision.

Dr Viral did various spine surgery fellowships in India. After a short stint of Private Practice, he went to South Korea for an advanced Spine Surgery Fellowship. That was the year 2006.

Since that time, he has worked as a consultant spine surgeon at leading hospitals in Ahmedabad. He continued serving patients among domestic and international society from 2008 to 2018, treated more than 10,000 patients with various spinal and orthopaedic elements. With a motive of giving something back to society, in 2018 he founded a centre of medical excellence, named Pushya hospital.



Some of Dr Viral Shah's Key Achievements are:

- First surgeon to do Intervertebral Disk Replacement Surgery in Ahmedabad in the year 2007
- First surgeon to do KYPHOP-LASTY, a procedure which restores the shape of a collapsed vertebra as a result of Osteoporosis. This revolutionary procedure enables a patient walk pain free a few hours after surgery.
- In a patient who had suffered neck injury and who had suffered near paralysis in his whole body from the neck downwards, Dr Viral corrected the position of the displaced cervical vertebra with surgery and the patient who was given up as incurable walked.

Without Dr Viral's surgery the patient would have been confined to bed for the rest of his life.

Something Different

Spine surgery is not about cutting and suturing. The patient must be pain free and should be able to walk and work after spine Surgery. One of the common reasons patients need spine surgery is tuberculosis of the vertebra leading to the collapse of the spine, severe pain and paralysis. It also results in kyphosis and scoliosis. Dr Viral had treated many such young patients and made it possible for them to walk. He used to visit some such patients who could not afford follow up visits in their homes to check they were capable of work.
